Dear Resident,

The Village of Long Grove wishes to notify you that as of **TODAY**, Checker Road will be **OPEN** to two-way traffic between Country Club Drive and Schaeffer Road. Meaning, Pease Construction, Inc. and their subcontractors (Joel Kennedy Construction, Mancini Underground Contractors and Matrix Utility Construction) have completed the installation of 2,600 linear feet of force main pipe, 15 sanitary manholes and 4,600 linear feet of 10" ductile iron sanitary sewer pipe with depths that reach up to 34 feet. Proper traffic control will be installed prior to the roadway opening. Please note that while this portion of Checker Road is open to two-way traffic, the Contractor will be performing miscellaneous construction tasks within the vicinity, which will require temporary single lane closures. Such work will include the testing of the installed sanitary sewer pipes, testing of the constructed sanitary manholes and miscellaneous work being performed at the proposed lift station. Eastbound traffic on Checker Road, east of Shenandoah Lane and west of Country Club Drive, will remain closed until further notice.

Due to timing and asphalt plants being closed for the winter, the excavated sending and receiving pits for the sanitary sewer main and sanitary manholes have been backfilled with aggregate. These patch areas have been compacted and leveled to provide as smooth a transition as possible to the existing pavement. The Village Engineer will routinely inspect the roadway for any areas in need of repair. The Contractor will make any necessary repairs as directed by the Engineer. It is encouraged that all residents continue to drive with caution through this portion of Checker Road due to the roadway conditions and the presence of construction activities. Please be aware that the posted construction zone speed limit of 15mph will be maintained along Checker Road, from Old Hicks Road to South Schaeffer Road.
