The Long Grove Historical Society will be hosting a Movie Night on Friday, January 25 at 7 p.m. at the Reed-Turner Woodland Nature Center (3849 Old McHenry Road). Admission is free. The movie, *The Public Enemy*, was released in 1931 starring James Cagney and Jean Harlow. It is a mobster tale loosely based on Chicago mobster and former Long Grove resident Terry Druggan. Prior to the movie, a few stories about "Terrible Terry" and his "Valley Gang" will be presented.

On Sunday, February 17 at 2 p.m. at the Reed-Turner Woodland, there will be a Fireside Chat. Admission is free. This program features John B. Byrne, author of *Images of America's Cuneo Museum and Gardens*. Mr. Byrne's family has an enduring bond with the Cuneo Estate. His grandfather was employed by Samuel Insull, Sr. and Mr. Byrne's family lived on the estate since 1957.
