**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 5 OF
TITLE 11 OF THE LONG GROVE VILLAGE CODE
REGARDING OUTDOOR MUSIC AT PUBLIC ASSEMBLIES**

WHEREAS, Chapter 5 of Title 11 of the Long Grove Village Code ("**Village Code**"), establishes permitting and other requirements relating to public assemblies (as defined in said Chapter 5); and

WHEREAS, current regulations effectively prohibit amplified music in the Village's historic downtown district; and

WHEREAS, because the Village has a long tradition of outdoor festivals in the historic downtown area, and because musical entertainment offers an important amenity for the success of such festivals, the Village President and Board of Trustees have determined that it is in the best interests of the Village and its residents to amend the regulations in Chapter 5 of Title 11 of the Village Code regarding amplified music as hereinafter set forth;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Long Grove, County of Lake, State of Illinois, as follows:

SECTION ONE. **Recitals.** The foregoing recitals are incorporated into this Ordinance as the findings of the President and Board of Trustees.

SECTION TWO. **Amendment to Section 11-5-7(D).** Subsection (D) of Section 11-5-7, entitled "Conduct of Public Assemblies," of Chapter 5, entitled "Public Assemblies on Private Property," of Title 11, entitled "Traffic Regulations," of the Village Code is hereby amended in its entirety as follows:

11-5-7 CONDUCT OF PUBLIC ASSEMBLIES

* * *

(D) Music.

- (1) No **Unless approved by the Village Board of Trustees, no** musical entertainment, either live or recorded, utilizing sound amplification equipment shall be operated in a **an outdoor** location which is less than three thousand feet (3,000') from any schoolhouse, church, dwelling unit, or any other place of permanent human habitation.
- (2) ~~, and there~~ **There** shall be no programmed entertainment provided between the hours of nine o'clock (9:00) P.M. and nine o'clock (9:00) A.M.; **provided that the Village Board of Trustees may, in its sole discretion and only by an affirmative vote of a majority of the Village Board members then holding office, authorize as part of a permit for a public assembly that programmed entertainment may extend until 10:00 p.m.**
- (3) **For any application for a public assembly permit at which amplified outdoor musical entertainment is requested, the application for such permit shall identify the location(s) at which such entertainment will be presented and the location(s) and directional orientation(s) of the speakers or other amplification devices to be used.**

SECTION THREE. Effective Date. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage, approval, and publication in pamphlet form in the manner provided by law.
