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**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 3, CHAPTER 2 AND SECTION 12-1-2 OF THE LONG GROVE VILLAGE CODE REGARDING TAPROOMS**

**WHEREAS**, the President and Board of Trustees have determined that it is in the best interests of the Village and its residents to modify the liquor control regulations contained in Title 3, Chapter 2 of the Long Grove Village Code ("**Village Code**") to create an annual license classification authorizing the operation of taprooms at state- and federally-licensed breweries, including tastings and retail sale for on- and off-premises consumption of beer produced on the licensed premises;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF LONG GROVE, COUNTY OF LAKE, STATE OF ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:**

**SECTION ONE.**     **Recitals.**     The foregoing recitals are incorporated into this Ordinance as the findings of the President and Board of Trustees.

**SECTION TWO.**     **Amendment to Section 3-2-1.** Section 3-2-1, titled "Definitions," of Chapter 2, titled "Liquor Control Regulations," of Title 3, titled "Business Regulations," of the Village Code is hereby amended in part as follows:

**3-2-1 DEFINITIONS**

Unless the context otherwise requires, the words and phrases used in this Chapter shall have the following definitions:

**BEER TASTING: The practice of allowing prospective purchasers to consume samples of beer, as herein defined, on the specific premises, to induce a sale at retail in the original package, as may be authorized by this chapter.**

**SECTION THREE.**     **Amendment to Section 3-2-5.** Section 3-2-5, titled "Liquor Classifications; Number; Fees," of Chapter 2, titled "Liquor Control Regulations," of Title 3, titled "Business Regulations," of the Village Code is hereby amended in part as follows:

### 3-2-5 LIQUOR CLASSIFICATIONS; NUMBER; FEES

The classification of licenses shall be as follows with the fees in subsection 12-1-2(G) of this code:

#### (O) Class O Taproom:

1. Classification: Class O licenses shall authorize the operation of a taproom on the same premises, and under the same ownership, as a brewery or craft brewery operated in compliance with state and federal licenses authorizing the manufacturing, storage, distribution, and sale of alcoholic beverages. A Class O license shall authorize the following at a taproom:
  - a. Retail sale of beer produced on the premises at a bar or table for on-premises consumption;
  - b. Retail sale of beer produced on the premises in its original, sealed package for off-premises consumption, provided that such beer shall be sold only in packs of not less than four cans or bottles, which packs may contain different varieties of beer;
  - c. Retail sale of beer produced on the premises in growlers for off-premises consumption, provided that such growlers contain not less than 32 fluid ounces, nor more than 68 fluid ounces, and are properly sealed for transport in compliance with state and federal law; and
  - d. Beer tastings of beer produced on the premises, provided that:
    - i. The beer tastings occur as part of a brewery tour on the premises; and
    - ii. The beer tastings comply with all applicable state and federal laws and, in any event, do not exceed five samples of three fluid ounces each per prospective purchaser per day.
2. The retail portion of the Class O licensed establishment, including beer tastings, shall be closed from [two o'clock (2:00) a.m. through nine o'clock (9:00) a.m.,] during which times no alcoholic liquor shall be sold, or offered for sale or tasting, on the premises.

**SECTION FOUR. Amendment to Section 12-1-2.** Section 12-1-2 titled "Fees," of Chapter 1, titled "Fee Schedule," of Title 12, titled "Fees and Costs" of the Village Code is hereby amended in part as follows:
