**Ordinance Amending Code Creating New Class A and Class V
Liquor Licenses For PUB 83 (Formerly Double G's)**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE LONG GROVE
VILLAGE CODE REGARDING LIQUOR LICENSES**
(PUB 83 – 4868 IL Route 83)

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Illinois Liquor Control Act, 235 ILCS 5/1-1 *et seq.*, the Village has the authority to license and regulate the retail sale of alcoholic beverages in the Village; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Chapter 2 of Title 3 of the Long Grove Village Code, the Village has adopted liquor licensing regulations for the sale of alcoholic beverages in the Village; and

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees have determined that it is in the best interests of the Village and its residents to amend the Long Grove Village Code, as set forth herein, to accurately reference the number of licenses in each classification;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Long Grove, County of Lake, State of Illinois, as follows:

SECTION ONE. **Recitals.** The foregoing recitals are incorporated into this Ordinance as findings of the President and Board of Trustees.

SECTION TWO. **Amendment.** Subsections (A) and (N) of Section 3-2-5, entitled "License Classification; Number; Fees;" of Chapter 2, entitled "Liquor Control Regulations," of Title 3, entitled "Business Regulations," of the Long Grove Village Code shall be, and are hereby, amended in their entirety, so that Subsections 3-2-5(A) and 3-2-5(N) shall hereafter be and read as follows:

3-2-5 LICENSE CLASSIFICATIONS; NUMBER; FEES: The classification of licenses shall be as follows:

(A) Class A Tavern:

1. Classification: Class A licenses shall authorize the retail sale on the premises of alcoholic liquors for consumption only on the premises where sold except between the hours of two o'clock (2:00) A.M. and nine o'clock (9:00) A.M.
2. Number: **34**
3. Fee: **\$2,750.00**

(N) Class V Limited License:

1. Classification: Class V licenses shall authorize the sale or distribution of alcoholic beverages on the premises in conjunction with video gaming devices, which license shall only be available to persons currently holding another liquor license issued by the Village on the licensed premises, which other license permits on-premises consumption of alcohol. Any person applying for a Class V license shall be required to present plans for the licensed premises that depict where the video gaming devices will be located. There shall be no flashing lights and no sound within five feet of the machine, and devices must be located so as not to distract diners. Such location shall (a) be segregated from other areas of the licensed premises where access to persons under 21 years of age is permitted, and (b) be situated within the licensed premises so as to ensure adequate supervision of the area in which the video gaming devices are located. No person shall be entitled to a Class V license unless the Local Liquor Control Commissioner grants such license, which license may be subject to conditions relating to the operations within the licensed premises
2. Number: 4- 5
3. Fee: \$250.00

SECTION THREE. **Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect after its passage, approval, and publication in pamphlet form in the manner provided by law.




