I have attached a copy of the draft for your code update. It highlights the items changed, added or deleted. There are a few additional items that we might need to discuss.


Any of the amendments that are in the new code, I deleted from the amendments. It is possible some of the items in the electric code will need some additional input. We can discuss these items when we meet again.

The following is a summary of the changes:

1. Updated the ICC codes to the 2015 edition
2. Updated the National Electric Code to the current edition
3. Updated the 3 Illinois Codes to the current edition adopted by the State of Illinois
Illinois Accessibility
Illinois Plumbing
Illinois Energy (2012 International Energy Conservation Code)
4. All of the amendments to the Illinois Plumbing Code were removed because they are no longer allowed.
5. Added the new ICC Swimming and Spa Code (2015 edition).
6. The section on right of entry in the Building Code was deleted from the amendments.
7. The sections on Carbon Monoxide were deleted because it is part of the code.
8. Deleted the section prohibiting OSB for roof and floor sheathing.
9. Added the definitions for new construction (Building and Fire Codes).
10. Deleted the residential sprinkler amendment because it is part of the code.
11. The Fire Code was rearranged and renumbered without many technical changes.
12. The NFPA referenced standards were undated to the most current editions.
13. The amendment, which added occupant load criteria, was deleted because it is in the new code.

This can be presented to the Board as a draft, but I feel we should meet one more time for some fine-tuning.
