RESOLUTION AWARDING A CONTRACT FOR ADDITIONAL VILLAGE ROAD PATCHING

WHEREAS, bids for the FY 2016/17 Village Road Paving and Patching Contract were received on March 10, 2016; and

WHEREAS, the Village has reviewed the proposals received and determined that the proposal of *Peter Baker & Son Company* was the most favorable to the interests of the Village;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF LONG GROVE, LAKE COUNTY, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: Recitals. The foregoing recitals are hereby incorporated herein as findings of the Village Board of Trustees.

Section 2: Waiver of Competitive Bidding; Approval. The President and Board of Trustees, pursuant to an affirmative vote of at least two-thirds of its Trustees, hereby waive competitive bidding in accordance with Section 8-9-1 of the Illinois Municipal Code with respect to the Road Paving Work. The President and Board of Trustees hereby approve the FY 2016/17 Additional Road Paving and Patching Contract for road paving work with *Peter Baker & Son Company* in the total amount not to exceed \$419,634.97 conditioned upon the receipt of all contractually required documentation and such other additional information that may be requested by the Village Manager in accordance with the Contract that is acceptable to the Village of Long Grove.

Section 4: Effective Date. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval in the manner provided by law.

Re: Additional Road Options
2016 Road Program

As discussed, we have evaluated the costs to add streets to the 2016 Road Program in efforts to maximize the amount of roadways resurfaced this year. As discussed in our call on Monday, March 14, we have targeted an add of approximately \$400,000 to this year's road program. We recommend the following summary road segments be considered for inclusion:

The above costs do not include the Design Engineering, which is anticipated to be 3.75% of the construction costs (\$15,094.78) or additional pavement cores, which is anticipated to be approximately \$3,000.
