The Lake County Division of Transportation (LCDOT) is conducting a Public Hearing to provide an overview of the Aptakistic Road Preliminary Engineering and Environmental (Phase I) Study and to present the preliminary Preferred Alternative.

The purpose of the hearing is to seek public input on the proposed 5-lane roadway improvement for Aptakistic Road, between IL Route 83 and Buffalo Grove Road. The proposed improvement will address existing and future capacity, mobility, safety, and operational deficiencies associated with this section of roadway.

The hearing will be conducted in an open house format, and interested persons may attend anytime between 5:00 PM and 7:00 PM. Attendees will have the opportunity to view preliminary construction drawings, exhibits, provide comments, and meet with LCDOT and project study team representatives.

LCDOT is seeking public comments on the use of property from Churchill Park and Twin Creek Park associated with improvements to Aptakistic Road. These properties are owned and operated by the Buffalo Grove Park District and are protected by Section 4(f) of the U.S. Department of Transportation Act of 1966. LCDOT intends to seek a de minimis impact finding from the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) based on the project not adversely affecting the features, attributes, or activities qualifying the properties for protection under Section 4(f).



To Whom It May Concern:

According to our notes the original proposal for the widening of Aptakistic Road between Buffalo Grove Road and Route 83 was an additional two lanes.

We recommended adding only one additional lane.

By the following open meeting the proposal was five lanes plus additionally five foot sidewalks on both sides of the road.

We are unnerved by the expanse of hardscaping that is being proposed!

Where is Long Grove's commitment to keeping our Village's rural nature intact?

We understand the County's projected needs as to traffic concerns but feel they could be met with less impact to our's; i.e. by redressing the original four lane proposal.

If foot traffic is essential for whatever reason, perhaps a soft walkway (mulched or gravel) would be more in keeping with the rural nature of our Village. This alternative would maintain our Village's integrity while somewhat saving our greenspaces, monies, and upkeep costs. This area is not part of a city in need of access! Nor do we want to promote ingress to our Village.

All we are asking is that as little hardscaping be poured as is absolutely necessary for the vehicular needs of those passing through our Village on this quarter mile feeder road.

RESOLUTION NO. 2013-R-24**

**A RESOLUTION
CONDITIONALLY SUPPORTING THE WIDENING OF APTAKISIC ROAD
BETWEEN TWIN OAKS BLVD & IL ROUTE 83 WITHIN THE VILLAGE OF LONG GROVE**

WHEREAS, Aptakistic Road travels through the Village of Long Grove from the eastern Village boundary just west of Twin Oaks Boulevard (Village of Buffalo Grove) to IL Route 83; and

WHEREAS, the Lake County Division Of Transportation ("**LCDOT**") has designed and intends to construct certain improvements to Aptakistic Road, including widening Aptakistic from the current two lanes to five lanes between N. Buffalo Grove Road and Twin Oaks Boulevard within the boundaries of the Village of Buffalo Road; and

WHEREAS, LCDOT recently completed the widening of Aptakistic Road from two lanes to five lanes from N. Buffalo Grove Road to the easternmost terminus at Milwaukee Avenue within the Village of Buffalo Grove and the Village of Lincolnshire and beyond the boundaries of the Village of Long Grove; and

WHEREAS, with the planned widening of Aptakistic Road from two to five lanes for its' entire length beyond the boundaries of the Village of Long Grove, the narrowing of Aptakistic Road from five lanes to three lanes will eventually result in significant traffic congestion within Long Grove and neighboring communities as five lanes of traffic is reduced to two lanes; and

WHEREAS, the resulting traffic congestion results in increased cut-thru traffic on local roadways that intersect with Aptakistic Road within the Village and neighboring communities boundaries that are not designed nor intended to accept this additional traffic and increased wear and tear; thus threatening the safety of the public traveling on Aptakistic Road and the intersecting roadways, as well as the owners and residents of property adjacent to IL Aptakistic Road; and

WHEREAS, in recent years, there have been an increasing level of traffic congestion on Aptakistic Road, IL Route 83 and throughout Lake County; and

WHEREAS, in acknowledgement of the safety concerns, the rural character of the area, the increasing amount of congestion on Aptakistic Road, and to ensure the safety of the public while at the same time facilitating the free flow of traffic on Aptakistic Road, the Village requests that LCDOT develop plans for widening Aptakistic Road through the Village that reduces the roadway impact on neighboring residents and the natural environment by developing a roadway cross-section that minimizes each lane width and includes a mountable median and thereby minimizing the overall pavement "footprint"; and

WHEREAS, in furtherance of limiting the impact on the natural environment and minimizing the overall pavement "footprint", the Village requests that LCDOT develop plans for widening Aptakistic Road through the Village that do not include roadway related improvements within the platted scenic corridor easements located along the south side of Aptakistic Road; and

WHEREAS, the Village supports the widening of this last remaining portion of Aptakistic Road so long as the roadway cross-section incorporates these few design standards and that LCDOT continues to involve Village participation and input on the final design; and

WHEREAS, the Village has further determined that it is desirable and in the best interests of the Village and its residents that LCDOT install pedestrian pathways along the north and south sides of Aptakistic Road that connect the existing pathways in Long Grove with those in Buffalo Grove; including a pedestrian activated cross-walk at the intersection of Aptakistic Road and IL Route 83;

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village desire to further memorialize the Village's support for the widening of Aptakistic Road to five lanes subject to the minimal conditions set forth in this Resolution;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF LONG GROVE, LAKE COUNTY, ILLINOIS, as follows:

SECTION ONE. Recitals. The foregoing recitals are incorporated into this Resolution as findings of the President and Board of Trustees.

SECTION TWO. Widening of Aptakistic Road Between Twin Oaks Blvd and IL Route 83. The President and the Board of Trustees hereby memorializes its' support for the widening of Aptakistic Road between Twin Oaks Blvd and IL Route 83 within the Village of Long Grove conditioned upon the following:

1. Preservation of natural environment;
2. Minimal overall pavement width;
3. Mountable median/turning lanes;
4. No increased speed limits for all portions of Aptakistic Road located within the Village of Long Grove;
5. Installation of pedestrian paths along the south and north sides of Aptakistic Road, including a pedestrian activated cross-walk at the intersection of IL Route 83 & Aptakistic Road;
6. No new roadway lighting.

In furtherance of the Village's study and consideration of such traffic improvements, the Village President, Village staff, and the Village Engineer shall be authorized and directed to seek assistance from and work cooperatively with local and state transportation agencies, including without limitation, the Illinois and Lake County Departments of Transportation and the neighboring municipalities.

SECTION THREE: Effective Date. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect upon its passage and approval in the manner provided by law.







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ALTERNATIVES ANALYSIS



ALTERNATIVES ANALYSIS



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Principle Need Factors

- Traffic congestion and delay will increase up to 98% over existing conditions by the 2040 Design Year if no improvements are made.
- Congestion contributes to safety and access deficiencies.

Two alternatives analyzed

3-lane alternative

- Maintains 1 travel lane in each direction
- Adds median with exclusive left turn lanes
- Adds exclusive right turn lanes at side streets

5-lane alternative

- 2 travel lanes in each direction
- Adds median with exclusive left turn lanes
- Right turns occur from outside travel lanes



ALTERNATIVES ANALYSIS



APTAKISIC ROAD
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Evaluation based on County and State Design Standards and the Project Problem Statement

- Accommodate existing and projected Year 2040 traffic volumes
- Improve access to/from adjacent properties
- Improve bike/pedestrian accommodations
- Minimize environmental and adjacent property impacts
- Consider corridor design factors and traffic calming measures to the extent practical



DESIGN FACTORS



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IL Route 83 intersection

- 5 lanes on Aptakistic Road
- No IDOT plans for improvements to IL 83

Buffalo Grove Road intersection

- 5 lanes on west leg of Aptakistic Road
- Match proposed improvement to Buffalo Grove Road by Lake County

General

- Environmental considerations (wetlands, floodplains)
- Existing right-of-way width varies
- Discontinuous sidewalk and bike paths



ANALYSIS RESULTS:



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IL 83 to Brandywyn Lane

- 5-lane alternative results in lower travel time through corridor
- 5-lane alternative provides more gaps/longer gap times for better access to/from adjacent properties

Brandywyn Lane to Buffalo Grove Road

- 5-lane alternative at Brandywyn is required to meet County and State Design Standards for 2040 Design Year
- Additional turn lanes required at the Buffalo Grove Road Intersection




ALTERNATIVE ANALYSIS CONCLUSIONS



APTAKISIC ROAD
TOMORROW'S PROGRESS BEGINS TODAY. BE A PART OF IT.

- 5-lane alternative required from Brandywyn Lane to Buffalo Grove Road
- IL 83 to Brandywyn Lane, 5-lane results in lower travel times and improves accessibility to/from adjacent properties
- 5-lane alternative completes consistent roadway cross section from IL 83 to IL 21/US 45
- 5-lane alternative is supported by the Villages of Long Grove and Buffalo Grove




PRELIMINARY PREFERRED ALTERNATIVE NEAR HILLTOP

11' Lanes and Curb and Gutter used to Reduce Adjacent Property Impacts








ARLINGTON HEIGHTS ROAD TO HILLTOP



Potential Noise Walls


- Traffic Noise impacts evaluated for entire project limits
- 8 Common Noise Environment areas were evaluated
- Area south of Aptakistic near Brandywyn is the only area that meets IDOT/FHWA requirements for Traffic Noise Walls
- Separate Traffic Noise Meeting held on December 17, 2014
- Based on current benefited receptor input, the traffic noise walls will be installed
- Coordination with these benefited receptors will continue through the Public Hearing comment period

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
