Notice from Village of Lake Zurich

Lake Zurich Sanitary Sewer Repair Work Underway in Village of Long Grove

The Village of Lake Zurich operates and maintains a sanitary sewer transmission line from Lake Zurich to the Lake County treatment facility located in the Village of Buffalo Grove. En route to the treatment facility, the line passes through the Villages of Kildeer and Long Grove.

Soon after midnight on September 19, 2015, the Village was advised of a sewer collapse on East Cuba Road about 500 feet west of Old McHenry Road in the Village of Long Grove. Village crews were immediately dispatched and together with a contract excavator, Berger Excavating, were on the scene and spent the next several hours attempting repair to the sewer. During the repair, a portion of East Cuba Road was closed to through traffic.

Later in the day, it became evident that the scope of the sewer collapse was greater than initially expected. The repair focused on a 12 foot section of sewer but it is now clear that the problem is more widespread. Additional sections of the sanitary sewer line are in need of repair or replacement. What was first thought to be a repair that would be completed by Saturday evening could now last several days. While crews are on site, East Cuba Road will be down to one lane and for a limited time may be closed entirely to traffic.

The Village of Lake Zurich apologizes to its municipal neighbors in Kildeer and Long Grove and their residents for this inconvenience. It is Lake Zurich's intent to make the repair as quickly as reasonably possible while doing its best to minimize the inconvenience to impacted residents and motorists.
