**AN ORDINANCE DESIGNATING THE ROBERT PARKER COFFIN ROAD
COVERED BRIDGE AS AN HISTORIC LANDMARK**

WHEREAS, currently Chapter 6 of Title 11 of the Village Code of the Village of Long Grove (the "**Village**") regulates use of the covered bridge located along Robert Parker Coffin Road approximately 1,000 feet westerly of the intersection of Robert Parker Coffin Road and Old McHenry Road (the "**Covered Bridge**"); and

WHEREAS, section 65 ILCS 5/11-48.2-1, *et seq.*, of the Illinois Municipal Code (the "**Historic Preservation Law**") authorizes the corporate authorities of a municipality to provide for official landmark designation by ordinance of areas, places, buildings, structures, works of art and other objects having a special historical, community, or aesthetic interest; and

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Long Grove (the "**Village Board**") has determined that the Covered Bridge has a special historical, community, and aesthetic interest; and

WHEREAS, the Village Board has determined that it is in the best interests of the Village and its residents to designate the Covered Bridge as an official historic landmark under the Historic Preservation Law;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Long Grove, County of Lake, State of Illinois, as follows:

SECTION ONE. **Recitals.** The foregoing recitals are incorporated into this Ordinance as findings of the President and Board of Trustees.

SECTION TWO. Designation of Historic Landmark. The Covered Bridge is hereby designated as an official historic landmark pursuant to the Historic Preservation Law. As an official historic landmark, the Covered Bridge may be subject to historic preservation conditions and regulations that may from time to time be established upon notice and public hearing pursuant to the Historic Preservation Law and the Village Code.

SECTION THREE. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage, approval, and publication in pamphlet form in the manner provided by law.
