FY13 State Budget Preserves LGDF and Most CPPRT Revenue

The IML Legislative Team is pleased to report to our members that the General Assembly has approved an FY13 state budget that leaves Local Government Distributive Fund (LGDF) revenue intact while diverting \$12 million in Corporate Personal Property Replacement Tax (CPPRT) revenue to fund costs associated with Regional Superintendents of Education (ROE). This diversion represents slightly less than 1% of total CPPRT revenues. Municipalities receive 20% of all CPPRT revenues, so the diversion totals approximately \$2.4 million spread out over all municipalities that receive CPPRT across the state. The diversion represents a continuation of the policy pursued by the General Assembly and Governor during the 2011 Fall Veto Session. The IML Legislative Team would like to thank each of our members that contacted their legislators to urge that local revenues be protected.
