Recently Deputy Patterson responded to an address in Long Grove, IL for a 911 Hang Up/Unknown Problem. Dispatch reported the Juvenile caller admitted smoking a substance referred to as "Peach Out" and consuming alcohol.

Upon arrival Deputy Patterson spoke with the Juvenile who appeared very scared and complained of his heart racing. Juvenile was subsequently transported to the hospital by rescue. Deputy Patterson collected the "Peach Out" described as brown and green in color with an appearance similar to cannabis.

On 03/17/10 the Northern IL Police Crime Lab notified CID with identification of the substance, citing this as their first encounter with this substance.

The substance is known as **K2** and its street names of "**peace out**" and "**spice**". K2 apparently smells like potpourri and has an effect three times that of cannabis. K2 is created as a synthetic substitute for marijuana's active ingredient (THC) and is mixed with incense. The substance is currently legal to sell, purchase and possess. States apparently are attempting to classify and outlaw its use, yet have not yet done so.


**Subject:** Oakwood and Briarcrest Burglaries




