N. Krueger Road Public Meeting – December 15, 2016
(Woodlawn School, 6362 Gilmer Road)

Dear Long Grove Residents,

The Village of Long Grove has made application for Federal Funding that would pay for 80% of the cost to reconstruct North Krueger Road in 2018. The Village is pursuing Federal Funding in an effort to maximize the use of Village Funds to repave our public roads and as a mechanism to reconstruct and correct various aspects of the current roadway pavement for North Krueger Road. As part of this reconstruction, the design will replace the existing 22' wide roadway pavement and add 3' of paved shoulder on each side. The Village is proposing adding the 3' wide paved shoulder to protect the edge of pavement and to provide a "safe harbor" buffer for drivers and formalizing the shoulder by adding gravel and re-shaping the ditch lines. For reference, the proposed cross-section is very similar to that used by Lake County with the closest examples being Gilmer Road and Diamond Lake Road. The attached Invitation and Handout provide further details on the proposed project.

As part of the Village's efforts to solicit public input for these planned improvements, the Village will be hosting an informational public meeting at Woodlawn Middle School (6362 Gilmer Road) on Thursday, December 15, 2016 from 5:30 PM until 7:30 PM. Additional information on this project will be presented during the public informational meeting. Those interested are encouraged to attend this meeting to learn more about the project and to provide input. For those unable to attend the meeting, the materials will be posted to the Village's website following the meeting with public comment requested by December 31, 2016.

The Village will be distributing this information through regular mail and other available means but you are encouraged to please share this email and information with your friends and neighbors so that they are aware of the project and the opportunity to provide input.

Improvements will consist of providing a uniform 22-foot wide, two lane pavement section with 3-foot paved shoulders and 1-foot aggregate shoulders throughout the entire corridor. North Krueger Road Improvements

IL Rte 22 to Gilmer Road

Public Informational Meeting – December, 15 2016

PROJECT OVERVIEW

Due to the poor condition of the existing pavement, the Village of Long Grove requested and secured federal Surface Transportation Program (STP) funding for improvements to North Krueger Road between IL Rte 22 and Gilmer Road. This improvement will consist of a cost saving and effective rehabilitation technique which involves pulverizing the existing asphalt pavement, spreading and compacting it for use as a base and constructing a new pavement travel surface on top. Improved paved shoulders will be provided for the length of the corridor. Surface Transportation Program funds awarded by the Lake County Council of Mayors will cover 80% of the project's construction cost.

KEY PROJECT NOTES


- North Krueger Road will be rehabilitated for the entire project limits.
- Standard radii are proposed at all local street intersections throughout the corridor.
- A uniform 22-foot wide, two lane pavement section with 3-foot paved shoulders and 1-foot aggregate shoulders will be provided throughout the entire corridor.
- Minor profile adjustments will be made to improve sight lines.
- Construction will commence just north of Krueger Court to match the proposed reconstruction of N Krueger Road that will be constructed as part of the Future IDOT IL Rte 22 improvement project.
- Construction activities along the project corridor will require a detour route along Gilmer, IL Rte 83 and IL Rte 22. However local traffic access will be maintained for residents throughout the construction period.
- Retaining walls are proposed at two locations to minimize Right of Way and Tree Removal impacts while improving culvert drainage.
- Formal preparation of construction documents are expected to commence in 2017.
- Construction is currently planned to start in 2018.





GILMER ROAD TO IL RTE 22
