**RESOLUTION APPROVING AN
AGREEMENT WITH WASTE MANAGEMENT OF ILLINOIS, INC**

WHEREAS, in 1998, the Village solicited proposals for refuse collection and disposal service, recyclable collection, and landscape waste collection in accordance with a request for proposals ("**RFP**"); and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the RFP, in 1999 the Village awarded a contract ("**Initial Contract**") to Waste Management of Illinois, Inc. ("**WMI**"), which is a wholly-owned subsidiary of Waste Management, Inc., a Delaware corporation; and

WHEREAS, in 2004 the parties extended the Contract for an additional five years, ending January 31, 2009; ("**Contract Extension**"); and

WHEREAS, in 2004, the Village Board approved Resolution 2004-R-25 and the parties further amended the Contract to provide for leaf collection services; and

WHEREAS, in 2007, as provided for the in 2004 Contract Extension, the Village Board approved Resolution 2007-R-33, and the parties further extended the Contract for an additional five years, ending January 31, 2014 (the Initial Contract, as extended and modified by the Contract Extension and any amendments, shall hereinafter be referred to as the "**Contract**"); and

WHEREAS, the parties desire to extend the Contract for an additional five years, effective February 1, 2014, and ending January 31, 2019 and amend the terms of the Contract as set forth in the Letter from WMI dated March 12, 2013, attached to this Resolution as Exhibit A ("**Extension Letter**"); and

WHEREAS, the Village Board has determined that it is in the best interests of the Village and its residents to approve the Extension Letter as hereinafter set forth;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Long Grove, County of Lake, State of Illinois, as follows:

SECTION ONE: Recitals. The foregoing recitals are incorporated into this Resolution as findings of the President and Board of Trustees as if fully set forth in this Section One.

SECTION TWO: Approval of Extension. The Extension Letter is hereby approved in substantially the form attached to this Resolution as Exhibit A, subject to the receipt of an executed version of the Final Extension Letter from WMI.

SECTION THREE: Authorization. The Village Board hereby authorizes and directs the Village Manager to execute and deliver to WMI the Extension Letter.

SECTION FOUR: Effective Date. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval in the manner provided by law.

Proposal for Contract Extension

Dear Mr. Lothspeich:

Waste Management of Illinois, Inc. ("WM") sincerely appreciates the opportunity to offer Village of Long Grove ("Village") the following proposal to extend our current contract for comprehensive waste, recycling and environmental services. Our proposal is backed by our commitment to provide the highest quality service to our customers.

As you know, the Village of Long Grove and WM have been partners in waste and recycling for a long time. In recognition of this long-standing partnership, WM would like to offer enhancements to the services we currently provide. This would be an all inclusive recycle cart program Village wide and an option for a recycling rewards program for residents. We are open to discuss these and any other services that the Village would like to consider as you continue to enhance the services you provide to your residents.

WM proposes to provide for the Village's future refuse, recycling, and special event needs, as follows:

Term

The terms outlined in this letter will be effective February 1, 2014. The terms of the contract between the Village and WM that is currently in place (the "Current Contract"), will therefore be extended for a period of five years (i.e., extending to and through January 31, 2019). To the extent there is any inconsistency between with the Current Contract and the terms set forth in this letter, the terms of this letter shall control.

5-Year Contract Extension Proposal

Beginning February 1, 2014, WM will provide services in the Village as follows:

1. Unlimited Cart service
96 g \$19.45 per month

2. Limited Cart service
 - 96 g \$18.35 per month
 - 64 g \$17.32 per month
 - 35 g \$16.29 per month
3. Trash/Yard Waste Sticker \$2.50 each
4. Seasonal Yard Waste Service -\$60 year one, \$75 year two, \$95 year three, CPI annual adjustment final two years as stated in #7
5. Back Door Service add \$8.00 per month per service (trash/recycling) year 1, \$10 per month year 2, \$12 per month year three, CPI annual adjustment final two years as stated in #7.
6. No 2x a week service available, extra pickup \$17.00 per yard with 1 yard minimum.
7. Years 2-5 Pricing: CPI 2% min - 4% maximum
8. 65g recycle cart to all households combined with an annual monthly window for residents to upgrade to a 96 g cart for recycling at no charge starting in May 2015.
9. Residents may change the size of their refuse carts one time a year in the month May for no additional charge, there will be a \$25.00 fee to do it outside the month of May.
10. WM to produce a brochure outlining new changes to the service.
11. Service included for annual Heritage Run/Walk
12. Continuation of \$1.00 per bag leaf collection for 6 weeks each fall.

*Carts may be used and based on availability.

As detailed in Appendix A, the following additional services will be offered to the Village at no additional charge.

- **65g Recycle Carts for Recycling**
- **Waste Watch**

Renewal of Service

Any extension or renewal of the terms of service after January 31, 2019 shall be subject to the mutual agreement of the Village and WM.

Appendix A - Additional Services offered to Village of Long Grove

In conjunction with the contract for collection of refuse, recyclables, and yard waste from Village of Long Grove, Waste Management will provide the following value-added services to the Village:

1. 65g Recycle Carts

Waste Management will supply each household with a 65g cart for recycling. We will also an annual monthly window for residents to upgrade to a 96 g cart for recycling at no charge starting in 2015.

2. Waste Watch

As an ongoing part of our service offering, we would like to continue to offer our Waste Watch program to the Village of Long Grove at no charge. Our trucks are on your streets every day. Our drivers are familiar with their routes, so they're often the first to notice when something is amiss. As your community partner, we will assist the police and fire departments by acting as extra eyes and ears on the streets.

Through our Waste Watch program, we provide training to our drivers in what to look for and how to report suspicious or criminal activity to the police department. It is our hope that this partnership will assist the Buffalo Grove police force in putting an end to the "Rusc Burglarics" situation that the Village has been recently experiencing.

Since its debut, Waste Watch has received national acclaim for its support of law enforcement, emergency services, Highway Watch, Neighborhood Watch and the Amber Alert system. It has also earned recognition from municipalities and organizations including the National Sheriff's Association.
