

Resolution Re-appointing Arts and Deputy Arts Commissioners

**A RESOLUTION REAPPOINTING
THE VILLAGE ARTS COMMISSIONER & DEPUTY ARTS COMMISSIONER**

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village desire to encourage and promote cultural events, arts and music programs in the Village; and

WHEREAS, on May 9, 2006, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village adopted Resolution No. 2006-R-15, establishing the position of Village Arts Commissioner for the purpose of coordinating, promoting, and implementing cultural events and arts and music programs in the Village and appointed Tobin Fraley as Village Arts Commissioner for a one-year term; and

WHEREAS, on May 12, 2009, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village adopted Resolution No. 2009-R-14 reappointing Tobin Fraley as Village Arts Commissioner and establishing the new position and appointing Bob Denaro as Deputy Arts Commission for a one-year term expiring May 15, 2010; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Long Grove, County of Lake, State of Illinois, as follows:

SECTION ONE. **Recitals.** The foregoing recitals are incorporated into this Resolution as findings of the President and Board of Trustees.

SECTION TWO. **Reappointment of Village Arts Commissioner & Deputy Arts Commissioner.** The President and the Board of Trustees shall, and do hereby, reappoint Tobin Fraley as Arts Commissioner and Bob Denaro as Deputy Arts Commissioner for a term expiring April 30, 2011; provided, however, that such term may be renewed for additional terms by resolution of the President and Board of Trustees.

SECTION FIVE. **Effective Date.** This Resolution shall be in full force and effect after its passage, approval, and publication in pamphlet form in the manner provided by law.
