Project Process

- The project study will look at reconstructing Old McHenry Road within Downtown Long Grove
- The existing pavement is deteriorating and there is poor drainage along Old McHenry Road within the Project Study limits
- The project will also include analyzing the Old McHenry Road at Robert Parker Coffin Road intersection



Existing Conditions

- Old McHenry Road constructed in 1947 and last resurfaced in 1992
- Old McHenry Road at Robert Parker Coffin Road is an all-way stop-controlled intersection
- Pedestrian accommodations are provided within Downtown Long Grove




Project Schedule

Community Advisory Group
