AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 2011-O-21 ESTABLISHING VILLAGE OF LONG GROVE SPECIAL SERVICE AREA FOR PROVIDING LAKE MICHIGAN WATER TO THE HERONS LANDING SUBDIVISION

WHEREAS, the Village of Long Grove ("**Village**") is an Illinois municipal corporation that is authorized to establish special service areas for the purpose of providing special services to designated areas within its boundaries pursuant to Article VII, Section 7 of the Illinois Constitution and 35 ILCS 200/27-5, *et seq.* ("**SSA Law**"); and

WHEREAS, on 28 June 2011, the Board of Trustees of the Village ("**Village Board**") adopted Ordinance No. 2011-O-21 (the "**SSA Establishing Ordinance**"), which established a special service area (the "**Herons Landing Water SSA**") pursuant to the SSA Law for the construction of new water distribution facilities to provide a potable water supply from Lake Michigan water (the "**Special Services**"); and

WHEREAS, the SSA Establishing Ordinance established a maximum annual SSA tax levy to be imposed pursuant to a special tax roll and authorized the issuance of bonds to finance the Special Services; and

WHEREAS, in reviewing the scope of the Special Services and the financing therefor, the Village Board has determined that the Herons Landing Water SSA will benefit from amending provisions in the SSA Establishing Ordinance regarding issuance of bonds and the special tax roll in the following respects:

- A. The issuance of bonds for the Special Service. The SSA Establishing Ordinance authorizes the issuance of bonds to finance the Special Services. Section 5(a) of the SSA Establishing Ordinance is proposed to be amended to authorize the issuance of bonds in a maximum amount not to exceed \$3,000,000.00, which bonds may be payable over not more than a 30-year period, at an interest rate

WHEREAS, the President and Village Board have determined that it is in the best interest of the Village and its residents to amend the SSA Establishing Ordinance regarding the issuance of bonds and the special tax roll for the Herons Landing Water SSA, as hereinafter set forth;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF LONG GROVE, COUNTY OF LAKE, AND STATE OF ILLINOIS, as follows:

SECTION ONE: Recitals. The foregoing recitals are incorporated herein as findings of the President and Board of Trustees.

SECTION TWO: Authority. The Herons Landing Water SSA was established and is hereby amended pursuant to the provisions of the SSA Law, 35 ILCS 200/27-5 *et seq.*

SECTION THREE: Findings.

(a) The Herons Landing Water SSA was established on 28 June 2011, pursuant to proper notice and public hearing, by the SSA Establishing Ordinance. The Herons Landing Water SSA consists of the contiguous territory legally described in Exhibit A attached hereto and, by this reference, incorporated herein and made a part hereof. An accurate map of said territory is attached hereto and, by this reference, incorporated herein and made a part hereof as Exhibit B. The purpose of the Herons Landing Water SSA is to provide special municipal services to the territory within the boundaries of the Herons Landing Water SSA in the nature of constructing new potable water distribution facilities.

(b) The Proposed Changes were considered by the Village Board pursuant to "An Ordinance Proposing an Amendment to Village of Long Grove Special Service Area for Herons Landing Subdivision Water System," being Ordinance No. 2011-O-23, adopted on 23 August 2011.

(c) The Proposed Changes were considered at a public hearing convened, held, and closed on 23 August 2011. Said hearing was held pursuant to notice duly published in the *Daily*

Herald, a newspaper of general circulation within the Village of Long Grove, on 8 August 2011, which was at least 15 days prior to the hearing, and also pursuant to notice by United States mail addressed to the person or persons in whose name the general taxes for the last preceding year were paid on each property lying within the special service area. Said notice was posted on 12 August 2011, which was at least 10 days prior to the hearing. A Certificate of Publication of Notice and an Affidavit of Mailing of Notice are attached hereto, and by this reference, incorporated herein and made a part hereof as Exhibits C and D, respectively. Said notices conform in all respects to the requirements of the SSA Law.

(d) At the public hearing on 23 August 2011, all interested persons were given an opportunity to be heard on the Proposed Changes.

(e) Based upon their consideration of the data presented to the Board of Trustees and the testimony at the public hearing, the President and Board of Trustees hereby find that: (i) no objection to the Proposed Changes has been filed by 51% of the owners of record of property within the Herons Landing Water SSA and 51% of the electors residing within the Herons Landing Water SSA; and (ii) it is in the best interest of the Village and of the residents, occupants, and property owners within the Herons Landing Water SSA that the Proposed Changes be implemented by amending the SSA Establishing Ordinance as described in this Ordinance.

(f) The territory within the Herons Landing Water SSA is contiguous as required by the SSA Law. The Proposed Changes will not affect the boundaries or contiguity of the Herons Landing Water SSA.

(g) The Board of Trustees hereby determines that furnishing the Special Services in the Herons Landing Water SSA, as hereby amended and subject to the Proposed Changes, serves the common interests of the residents and owners within the Herons Landing Water SSA, which residents and owners will benefit specially.

SECTION FOUR: Amendment to SSA Establishing Ordinance. Pursuant to the SSA

Law, the SSA Establishing Ordinance is hereby amended as follows:

A. Amendment to Section 5(a). Section 5(a) of the SSA Establishing Ordinance is hereby amended in its entirety so that said Section 5(a) shall hereafter be and read as follows:

(a) Bonds, Construction Tax. The Herons Landing Water SSA is hereby authorized to issue bonds in a maximum amount not to exceed \$3,000,000.00, which bonds may be payable over not more than a 30-year period. Such bonds may be tax-exempt or taxable, but may only be issued at an interest rate not exceeding nine percent (9.0%) per annum as a net yield. The maximum annual taxes to be extended within the special service area in any year for the construction of the Special Service and/or payment of principal and interest on any bonds issued to finance such construction is hereby established to not exceed \$2,500 per single family residential lot, which payments may not continue for more than 30 years. The taxes described in this Section 5(a) will be payable within the Herons Landing Water SSA pursuant to a special tax roll, as further described in Section 5(b), below. Following the construction of the water system and after the life of the bonds, the County of Lake will be responsible for maintenance of the water system providing the Special Service pursuant to an intergovernmental agreement with the Village. The Village Board has determined that the issuance of bonds for the Special Service, as herein set forth, affords a reasonable means of financing the Special Services authorized under the SSA Establishing Ordinance.

B. Amendment to Section 5(b). Section 5(b) of the SSA Establishing Ordinance is hereby amended in its entirety so that said Section 5(b) shall hereafter be and read as follows:

(b) Special Tax Roll. The SSA taxes that may be imposed pursuant to section 5(a) will be payable pursuant to a special tax roll. The special tax roll will allocate annual SSA taxes equally on a per-single-family-residential-lot basis among the lots within the Subject Territory, except Lot 123 (which Lot 123 cannot be developed with any single family residence). The President and Board of Trustees have determined that: (i) such special tax roll is a fair and reasonable basis for allocating the SSA taxes in light of the equal access that each single family residential lot within the Subject Territory will have to the Special Services and the corresponding value to each such single family residential lot resulting from such access, both in terms of potable water use within or available to each single family residence and in terms of fire protection; and (ii) the special tax roll provides a rational relationship between the amount of taxes to be levied upon each lot, block, tract, or parcel of land within the Herons Landing Water SSA and the benefit to be rendered from the Special Services.

SECTION FIVE. Filing; Recordation. The Village Clerk is hereby directed and required to file and record this Ordinance and any other required materials with the Lake County Clerk or the Office of the Lake County Recorder.

SECTION SIX. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage, approval, and publication in pamphlet form in the manner provided by law.




