Pathways Committee Recommendation

Illinois Route 22 Pathway

The Long Grove Pathway recommends 10' asphalt "spine" pathway was the most appropriate type of pathway at this location on the south side of Illinois Route 22 subject to resolution of the following concerns;

- 1) Why does the pathway stop at Heritage Lane?
- 2) Why are so many trees being removed along the north side of Route 22?
- 3) Is a landscaping plan proposed for tree replacement and if so when will tree planting occur?
- 4) What is the schedule for completion of the Route 22 improvements; including the pathway ?
- 5) What are the specific plans for the north Krueger Road intersection and is a pathway connection (stub) anticipated for a future tie-in along North Krueger Road ?

There was concern about the 20% match and where those funds would come from with this project. The consensus was that we were aware to the match and we would need to deal with the funding issue in the future.
