DIVISION 3. - ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT COMMISSION

Sec. 2-206. - Creation.

There is created the Libertyville Economic Development Commission, which shall consist of seven (7) members appointed by the president with the advice and consent of the board of trustees.

Sec. 2-207. - Term of members, chairman.

The term of eight (8) members of the commission created in this division shall be four (4) years each. All terms shall end on April 30 of the designated year. One (1) member shall be designated chairman by the president with the advice and consent of the board of trustees and shall serve as chairman until April 30 of the ensuing year or until his successor has been designated.

Sec. 2-208. - Organization.

The members of the economic development commission shall elect any other officers that they may deem necessary, and shall hold such meetings and establish such rules and regulations as the commission shall deem necessary and proper for carrying on its functions.

Sec. 2-209. - Powers and duties.

- (a) The economic development commission shall assist both existing and prospective industrial or commercial firms to expand, extend, locate or relocate in the village so as to coordinate and maximize business growth within the community.
- (b) The commission shall cooperate with all other agencies of the village, county and state governments as well as such private organizations as will help further the goals of the commission.
- (c) The commission shall render advice and recommendations to the president and village board as it may deem appropriate or as may be requested.
- (d) No member of the commission shall enter into any contractual obligation, pay bills, or solicit or collect money without approval and consent of the president and board of trustees.
