

**AN ORDINANCE
AMENDING THE VILLAGE CODE REGARDING
WASTE HAULERS**

98-0-26

BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Long Grove, Lake County, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION I: That Section 8-10-3-(A) of the Village Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

SECTION 8-10-3-(A): No waste hauler shall perform waste hauling operations within the Village unless the hauler shall have a valid solid waste permit from the Village. Effective February 1, 1999, the Village has elected to award an exclusive franchise for refuse, yard waste, and recyclables collection and disposal from all single-family homes. Therefore, as of February 1, 1999, no waste hauler, other than the exclusive franchisee, shall collect or dispose of refuse, yard waste, or recyclables from any single-family residence.

SECTION II: That Section 8-10-3-(F) of the Village Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 8-10-3-(F): The waste hauler which possess the exclusive franchise as to single-family residences shall be required to offer three (3) waste removal services:

1. Conventional waste disposal.
2. **Recyclable Commodities:** The minimum commodities that must be collected separately once weekly and recycled include:
 - a. Newspaper
 - b. Aluminum beverage containers
 - c. Bi-metal and metal food containers

- d. All #1-7 plastic containers
- e. Corrugated cardboard
- f. Chipboard
- g. Magazines
- h. Junk mail
- i. Clear, brown and green glass

3. Yard waste material service.

SECTION III: All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith be and the same are hereby expressly repealed to the extent and only to the extent they are in conflict herewith.

SECTION IV: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect after its passage, approval, and publication, as provided by law.


