Chad,

The Village of Long Grove has reviewed the proposed route and the event will require approval by the Village Board as a Special Event. Please complete the attached application and submit to me for processing. Please submit the application by Tuesday, July 10 so that the request can be included on the next Village Board agenda on July 10, 2012. I have copied the following entities on the email so that they can coordinate directly with you:

Long Grove Fire Protection District - Marc Small.
Long Grove Business and Community Partners - Rachel Perkal.
Lake County Sheriff - Brian Keller.

Assuming approval by the Village Board and the other agencies, the Village will contact the adjoining homeowner associations via email and will provide a general note to our Residents in our upcoming Newsletter. The Village will likely require that the event post temporary signs along the Route in Long Grove (Aptakisic, IL Route 83, Robert Parker Coffin Road, Old McHenry Road) one week (7 days) in advance of the event to notify motoring public and the residents. Please include as much of the event details in the Special Event application in an effort to limit questions. Also, it is recommended that the applicant attend the Board Meeting to answer questions and if you are unable to attend personally then I would suggest being available via conference call for the meeting.

If the riders need a place to stop rest/get something to eat/drink the Village owns a very nice parking lot along Robert Parker Coffin Road (Archer Parking Lot - located between IL Route 83 and Old McHenry Road) that we would offer for use and the businesses in the Historic Downtown may be interested in working with you to provide refreshments.

Thank you for submitting your request to use various County Highways for the Venus de Miles bicycle event Sunday, July 29, 2012. We offer the following comments:

1. LCDOT shall permit use of the following County Highways for your event: Duffy Lane, Riverwoods Road, Deerfield Road, Aptakisic Road, Old McHenry Road, Fairfield Road, Gilmer Road, Hawley Street, Midlothian Road, Winchester Road, St. Mary's Road, and Everett Road on Sunday, July 29, 2012 as requested. The permits will be classified as Temporary Highway Closure Permits under the Lake County Temp Hwy Closure & Utility/Facility Placement Ordinance. The Temporary Highway Closure Permits must be received prior to use of the County Highways for your event.
2. Our Ordinances are available online at <http://www.lakecountyil.gov/Transportation/Publications/Ordinances.htm>
3. Enclosed is an "Application to Request Temporary Closure of a County Highway". One application must be completed for each County Highway. There is a \$50 fee per application. The total application fee for 12 County Highways sums to \$600. (Check payable to "Treasurer, Lake County")
4. Based on the route maps provided for the two courses other jurisdictions may be affected by your event. Those agencies include: City of Lake Forest, City of Highland Park, City of Highwood, Village of Deerfield, Village of Bannockburn, Village of Riverwoods, Village of Lincolnshire, Village of Mettawa, Lake County Forest Preserve (Des Plaines River Trail), Village of Buffalo Grove, Village of Long Grove, Village of Hawthorn Woods, Fremont Township, Village of Mundelein, Village of Libertyville, Libertyville Township, and IDOT. 5. Below are additional comments on the specific highway lane closures requested.
 - a. Deerfield Rd – close westbound lane between Central Ave and Park Ave. This section of road is not controlled by LCDOT. Please work directly with the City of Highland Park and the Village of Deerfield.
 - b. Route 83 – close southbound lane between Aptakisic Rd and Robert Coffin Rd. This section of highway is not controlled by LCDOT. Please work directly with IDOT.
 - c. Gilmer Rd – close northbound lane between Schwerman Rd and Chevy Chase Rd. This is a County Highway. Police support will be required for this lane closure. Please provide a letter or e-mail from the Police Dept stating they will handle the traffic control for this lane closure on Gilmer Rd.
6. As we discussed over the phone the Everett Road bridge deck over the tollway (I-94) is under construction. On the date of the event traffic over the bridge will be reduced to one lane controlled by temporary traffic signals. The timing of the traffic signals is not designed for cyclist; however, the bikepath will be open for bikers to get over the bridge. There is signage directing bikers to the path but to reinforce the signage would you place a ride marshal at the Everett Rd and Riverwoods Rd roundabout to better guide participates to the bikepath.
7. On Midlothian Road LCDOT is constructing bikepath along the west side. The existing path will not be available for use but the road pavement will be open. This should not affect your event.


Proof of Insurance/Indemnification

1. Enclosed is Chapter 10: Indemnification from our Temp Hwy Closure & Utility/Facility Placement Ordinance. This outlines the Proof of Insurance information that must be provided to the County for the permits.

2. "Lake County and its officers, agents, and employees; Lake County Division of Transportation and its officers, agents, and employees" must be added as additional insured to the General Liability Policy. Sample separate endorsements are enclosed.




Venus de Miles Illinois - 61mi Route




